Visit Hafod Eryri, the award-winning visitor centre on the summit of Yr Wyddfa (Snowdon), by travelling on our unique Victorian railway in a traditional diesel train.

Enjoy a relaxed and scenic journey on our heritage diesel service. Between 1986 and 1992 the railway introduced four British-built diesel locomotives: *Ninian*, *Yeti*, *Peris* and *George*. Each is powered by a turbocharged Rolls-Royce six-cylinder engine and was built by the Hunslet Engine Company of Leeds, offering a comfortable way for groups to experience the spectacular route to the summit.

- Summit return journey of 2 ½ hours
- Clogwyn return journey of 2 hours

Railway Services

The Traditional Diesel Service operates every day to the summit from May to October, and to Clogwyn Station $\frac{3}{4}$ up the mountain during the early season from March (weather permitting).

Journey Durations

The Traditional Diesel Service to the summit can last up to two and a half hours, which includes a stop of approximately 30 minutes at the summit. All services to Clogwyn can take up to two hours, which includes a stop of approximately 30 minutes where the open mountainside offers stunning views. Please note: there are no facilities of any kind at Clogwyn.

Terms and Conditions

Groups are required to arrive 1 hour before departure to allow sufficient time for comfort breaks (there are no facilities on the trains), collection and distribution of tickets, watching a 10-minute film, and boarding the train.

Train departures cannot be delayed to allow for late arrivals as timings are critical for single track operation on the mountain. Low cloud and poor visibility do not stop the train from travelling.

Passenger number confirmation is required seven days prior to travel and this will be the amount invoiced.



Booking Procedure

To qualify for group rates your party will need to be comprised of 25 or more fare paying passengers. Any bookings that are amended to below 25 passengers will be liable to pay the full fare. Groups need to book in advance to guarantee a time slot. Your group must pay prior to travel or on the day, in one transaction, at the ticket office. Registered coach operators and group travel agencies wishing to be invoiced for the balance can call for information regarding an account. Existing account customers do not need to reapply.

Cancellations, Non Arrivals and Late Arrivals

Groups are required to confirm final numbers no later than seven days before travel. Passenger numbers cannot be changed on the day of your visit. If you arrive late for your departure time and miss your train you will still be charged for your whole booking.



Additional Information

A wheelchair can be accommodated on all of our new diesel carriages but capacity is limited so please call for further information. Only assistance animals may be carried on trains. The company reserves the right to close, temporarily withdraw or alter any of the facilities at any time without prior notice for technical, capacity or operational reasons or inclement weather.

Weather Conditions

The weather on Yr Wyddfa (Snowdon) is very unpredictable and can change very quickly. Trains cannot proceed all the way to the summit if weather conditions become severe i.e. high winds or snow and ice on the track. In such cases, trains will terminate at Rocky Valley, which is $\frac{5}{8}$ of the way to the summit. Unfortunately, when there are severe winds on the mountain, we cannot allow passengers to disembark at Rocky Valley.
